


Planned Giving Appeal 2023


It will cost <u>£850 a day</u> to fund The Bourne Parish this year and cost pressures on many items – staff salaries, costs of gas and electricity and repairs to buildings have increased significantly, some at **over 10%**. Most of these costs are incurred in the **General Fund**, which covers the day-to-day running costs of the parish, excluding **Youthwork**, which is funded separately.



Note: this excludes the 'one-off' cost of repairing **St Thomas's flat roof**, estimated at £30,000, which will be subject to specific fund-raising



Although our general fund costs in 2023 are around £10k lower than our forecast income, we urgently need to **rebuild cash reserves** which have fallen significantly in recent years and are now half the level we should be operating at. **Planned giving** represents over 70% of the income required to support our work.



Planned giving underpins the work of the parish, but the average level of **monthly giving** in The Bourne is over 20% lower than the average for Guildford diocese (2020-2022 figures).





How can I help?

If you give only occasionally to the parish or currently give by standing order, yellow envelope or Stripe please consider switching to the **Parish Giving Scheme**, which most of our supporters use. This has many advantages for you and for the parish:-

- **Gift Aid** is reclaimed by the PGS team and paid promptly to The Bourne improving cash flow and saving on our administration time and effort
- Direct debits can be set up on a monthly basis
- Donors can, if they wish, allow donations to increase in line with **CPI inflation** annually
- All donations can be completely anonymous
- It is easy to change donation levels if circumstances change
