EUCHARIST

The Back Row (mainly adults) usually sing at the 10.00 am Choral Eucharist service on Sundays, together with the Boys or the Girls, who alternate; the girls sing on their own on the first Sunday of the month; and the full choir sings on special occasions such as Easter Sunday. The choir and congregation sing the Gloria to settings by Thorne, Mathias and others. The choir usually sings the Sanctus, Benedictus and Agnus Dei to a variety of other settings. During Advent and Lent the Kyrie is sung in place of the Gloria. The Creed is said.

Settings of the Magnificat and Nunc Dimittis are sung at Choral Evensong at 6.30 pm on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month, together with a setting of the Responses, an anthem, one or more psalms and one or two hymns. The Back Row and Girls (2nd Sunday) normally alternate with the Back Row and Boys (4th Sunday), with the Chamber Choir standing in, for example, if the 2nd or 4th Sunday falls in the school half term holiday week.
